Future Tense - Overview

In this lesson, you'll find the rules for how to conjugate regular French Verbs in the future tense.

The basic rule on how the future tense works in French goes as follows:

REGULAR VERBS (most verbs)

The rules are pretty straight forward: take the infinitive of the verb and add the following endings:

- je chanter -ai
- tu chanter -as
- elle chanter -a
- il chanter -a
- on chanter -a
- nous chanter -ons
- vous chanter -ez
- ils chanter -ont
- elles chanter -ont
